ROLE OF THE MEMBER

It is understood that the members of the Clinton Township Board of Education have authority only when acting as a Board legally in session. The Board shall not be bound in any way by any action or statement on the part of any individual Board member except when such statement or action is in pursuance of specific instructions from the Board.

Members of the Board shall adhere to the Code of Ethics for Board members in Bylaw 0142.3.

No Board member, by virtue of his/her office, shall exercise any administrative responsibility with respect to the schools or as an individual command the services of any school employee.

Confidential information related to Board business shall be used only for the purpose of helping the Board member discharge his/her Board responsibilities. No Board member shall reveal information contained in a confidential record or received during a duly convened private session of the Board except when that information has been released to the public by the Board President or authorized spokesperson.

Board members visiting the schools for any reason shall observe district regulations for all visitors.
