- The board held its annual reorganization meeting on January 7, 2019, and conducted the following business;
 - Four new board of education members took the oath and became official members; Alison Grantham, Catherine Emery, Regina Figueroa and Catherine Riihimaki.

- Approved legal services for 2019-2020 for Porzio, Bromberg and Newman at an hourly rate of \$195 per hour for attorney time.
- Approved Parette-Somjen as Architect of Record at an hourly rate of \$164 for licensed architect.
- Adopted district curriculum for 2018-2019 school year.

Facilities and Finance Committee

- Authorized payment of bills for \$4,245,252.95 for the period ending January 28, 2019.
- Approved Michael Falkowski as interim Business Administrator.
- Approved a contract with School Business Office, LLC to provide school business services at a rate of \$5,000/month beginning January 22, 2019 thru June 30, 2019.

Personnel Committee

- Approves Jennifer Paccione as Supervisor of Instruction, Data & Assessment at a prorated salary of \$83,000.
- Authorizes the hiring of Jean Hansen as Confidential Clerical Aide (.5 FTE) at a prorated salary of \$24,000.
- Approved the hiring of Michael Falkowski as Interim Business Administrator/Board Secretary from January 22, 2019 through June 30, 2019 at a rate of \$500 per day.
