## Re: Virtual Instruction Option and Other Information

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Like most regions within the state, our region, Central West, is experiencing very high levels in Covid activity. As we continue to monitor the data and the needs of the Clinton Township School District, we are extending the optional virtual platform for the week of January 24 to January 28. A re-enrollment form will be distributed for families who are interested in participating. The form will be available from January 19 with a closing date of January 20.

### ★ Please note ★

***The enrollment form is required for all who are interested, including families currently enrolled in the virtual instruction option.***

## Other Information from the NJ Department of Health

**Mask Guidance for persons who have COVID-19 compatible symptoms or who test positive for COVID-19 returning to school on days 6-10:**

- Wear a mask when around others at home, in school, and in public (indoors and outdoors) for an additional 5 days. For these additional 5 days, ***schools should have a plan to ensure adequate distance during those activities (i.e., eating) when mask wearing is not possible. Time without mask being worn should be kept to minimum possible.*** CSTD has alternative arrangements for lunch and snack to maximize distancing to the greatest extent possible.
- On days 6-10, limit participation in extracurricular activities to only those activities where masks can be worn consistently and correctly, if activities are taking place.

**Mask Guidance for close contacts of someone with COVID-19 during the quarantine/monitoring period:**

- Wear a well-fitting mask when around others at home, in school, and in public (***indoors and outdoors***) for the full 10 days after the last close contact.
- On days 6-10, limit participation in extracurricular activities to only those activities where masks can be worn consistently and correctly, if activities are taking place.
